Re: May 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

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Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the May 2017 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

- 1) End of month, May 2017 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)
  - Increases in emergency shelter and transitional facility census occurred among both Continuums, with the shelter census on Oahu rising from 2,358 to 2,475 and on the Neighbor Islands from 645 to 751.
  - Overall, the HMIS end of month homeless census (excluding DV shelters) for the State of Hawaii rose 7% from 3,003 to 3,226. The total “vacant beds” when compared to the HIC capacity totaled 786. This was also the result of changes in program capacity for several prominent homeless service organizations.
  - Total Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 2,384 including 1,528 on Oahu and 856 on the Neighbor Islands. Both realized modest increases relative to April 2017.
  - 32 programs on Oahu and 22 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- 2) Consent report for entries during May 2017 (pp. 8-11)
  - The statewide consent to share rate remained constant at 75% in May among the 1,195 new intakes during the month.
  - PSH projects (94%), transitional facilities (93%) and emergency shelters (91%) had the highest consent rates. Outreach programs had the lowest consent rate (61%), however, the rate did increase by two points compared to April.
  - 35 programs had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during May 2017 (pp. 12-14)
  - The average LOS for all programs was 141 days (representing 1,427 exits), down 13 days compared to April.
  - Oahu averaged the highest LOS with 171 days, followed by Kauai (139), Maui (88) and Hawaii (61).
  - Emergency shelter LOS ranged from 57 days on Maui to 208 days on Kauai. Transitional shelter LOS ranged from 83 on Maui to 401 on Oahu.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during May 2017 (pp. 15-19)
  - Intake timeliness fell to 2.72 average days, down 0.54 days compared to April.
  - 21 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness rose slightly to 4.32 average days, a small increase relative to April.
  - 28 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter exits.
