Re: August 2016 HMIS Reports

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Attached for your review and dissemination to the two Continuums are the following HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted as of the 15<sup>th</sup> of September after the end of August (or later):

1) August 2016 Census Report – This is a program-by-program census report extracted from the HMIS system reporting the number of enrollments in each program for both HI-500 and HI-501 on the last day of month – August 31, 2016. These totals are matched with the facilities listed on the Housing Inventory Chart submitted to HUD in January 2016 with corrections based on current information.

Key issues impacting accuracy include: 1) Failure to **input discharge forms** causing census numbers for several agencies and programs to be significantly above 100% (e.g. Hope Services, KEO, KHAKO, U.S.VETS), 2) **Low census counts** which may be real or signify a problem with processing intakes (CCH, Housing Solutions), 3) **Inaccuracies with HIC table** compared to current program capacity, and 4) Assorted **idiosyncratic issues** with different programs including, but not limited to, IHS, U.S.VETS, Hope and Steadfast.

Active totals are listed for the Rapid ReHousing programs separately. There is no bed count associated with these programs so there is no capacity percentage or variance presented. Outreach census has not been analyzed thoroughly for issues, although HMIS Admin team did notice lack of discharges based on review of the Data Timeliness Report.

A two-month trend comparison has been put together for on-going comparison. **Programs highlighted in RED are deemed priorities for corrections.**

2) July 2016 Data Timeliness Report – This report is run for the three-month period from June 1, 2016 through August 31, 2016 using the CaseWorthy report function. The report is organized by type of program for easier review and comparability.

Timeliness for intakes and exits are much lower during this analysis time period compared to the previous analysis (intakes down from 18 to 11 days). **One major issue found is the paucity of discharges (713) compared to intakes (3,103) during this time period.** This impacts all reporting if discharges are not being done timely or at all.

3) Length of Stay Analysis – This report measures the average number of days persons stayed in programs among households/persons exiting during the two month period of July to August 2016. **Reducing CoC length of Stay for Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, and Outreach is a key HUD performance measure.** This measure will be tracked for comparison on a monthly and three-month average basis in the future. This report is the initial month.

## Report Definitions and Abbreviation Explanations

### Header Definitions:

HIC Beds: Total bed capacity as listed on the Housing Inventory Chart (HIC) submitted to HUD in the most recent NOFA funding application.

Census on July 31th: Report calculation by CaseWorthy totaling the number of active enrollments in program in the system on July 31th (last day of report month).

% HIC Beds: Represents the percent of beds filled as on the census day. The census number divided by the reported maximum bed number. Numbers greater than 100% represent overcapacity or counts that may contain errors (missing discharges).

Technical Openings: Represents the number of beds open/unused based on comparison of the HIC bed count and the census bed count. May not necessarily represent the actual beds available due to variation in family members per unit, off-line units and other circumstances. Provide a general comparison that can highlight potential issues. If filled or overfilled, value is set to zero.

NL – Not Listing. Either on HIC or in CaseWorthy program listing

NA – Not Applicable

SP – Special Populations that are confidential and not currently reported on CaseWorthy reports.
