

Summary of Key Points
Analysis of Exit Destinations by Program Type, County, and Program
For the Months of July and August 2017

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The HMIS admin team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS program discharge records for the months of July 2017 (n = 1,072) and August 2017 (n = 1,335). The analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by program.

The summary tables for each month show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing exit rates. Analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Monitoring the number and rate of exits to unknown destinations is important since it is now an integral part of HUD System Performance Measures (SysPM) reporting. Pages 12-13 of this report brief include the SysPM Data Quality reports submitted by both BTG and PIC for FY2016. The results from sections five through seven of the SysPM DQ can be compared to the monthly aggregate results to evaluate progress towards improving exit destination data quality.

Assessing the level of PH placements is an essential part of determining performance for the many projects that operate within the CoC. State and federal funding is becoming increasingly tied to performance in this key area. The analysis presented within the reporting aligns with SysPM Measure 7: Successful Placement from Street Outreach and Successful Placement in or Retention of Permanent Housing. Most recently submitted SysPM data for metrics 7a1 and 7b1-2 can serve as baselines for monthly comparative analysis. Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for both months was 33%; in July there were 353 exits to PH and in August 439 PH exits.
- It should be noted that Street Outreach and Emergency Shelter project types should not be evaluated solely on exits to PH. Placements into institutional settings, shelters, or residential projects are usually positive outcomes.
- July PH rates by county were Hawaii (44%), Oahu (36%), Maui (19%), Kauai (10%).
- August PH rates by county were Kauai (40%), Hawaii (38%), Maui (35%), Oahu (31%).
- Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Programs typically had the highest PH rates due to the inherent nature of these programs.
- The number of clients with unknown exit data increased from 365 to 414 clients, however, the missing exit data rate decreased from 34% in July to 31% in August.
- Oahu and Maui had the most exits to unknown locations in August, with 38% and 24% of all discharges exiting to these destinations. Usually the exits within these categories were from ES or Outreach projects, however, Maui also had a high rate within this category exiting from the TH project type.
- Oahu Homeless Outreach programs had the highest rate of missing exits in July (70%) and August (73%), which can generally be attributed to auto-exiting. This should continue to be monitored, however, especially with HPO contracts shifting towards a housing first approach.
