

**Report Brief on Compliance to  
Chronic Homeless Data Completion**  
For the Month of March 2017

The CPC HMIS Support team completed two reports relating to “Chronic Homeless” HMIS fields:

- 1) Analysis of all cases (n=7,008) active during the month of March 2017, and
- 2) Analysis of new cases (n=964) with intakes during the month of March 2017.

Chronic homeless data are collected for all adults entered in the HMIS. Key highlights include:

**All Cases Open during March 2017**

- A total of 30 percent, or 2,071 out of 7,008 adults, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field. This rate represents a drop from 48 percent during February 2017. It must be noted that approximately 4,000 outreach cases were auto-exited during March, which contributed greatly to the large drop.
- Comparing missing data by program type, Street Outreach had the highest level with 58%, followed by Safe Haven 33%, Permanent Supportive Housing 31%, Homeless Prevention 14%, Transitional Housing 13%, and Emergency Shelter 11%.
- 16 agencies had chronic homeless missing data rates of 20% or greater.

**All Cases Entered during March 2017**

- A total of 19 percent, or 181 out of 964, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field.
- Comparing missing data by program type, Outreach had the highest level with 37%, while all the other programs had a missing rate of between 2% to 4%. Two programs (KPHC and Salvation Army Maui) accounted for just over two-thirds (122) of the cases with missing data.
- Only 5 agencies had chronic homeless missing data rates of 20% or greater.

**Next Steps:**

1. The CPC HMIS support team will continue to monitor data on a monthly basis.
2. Agencies should be tasked with correcting missing data for chronic homeless calculated fields for all active cases and other cases during the past year.
3. Additional training for agencies that have missing rates above 20%.
