Re: April 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

---

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the April 2017 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

- 1) End of Month April Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)
  - Significant drops in emergency shelter and transitional facility census occurred among both Continuums, with the shelter census on Oahu dropping from 2,604 to 2,358 and on the Neighbor Islands from 765 to 537.
  - Overall, the HMIS end of month homeless census (excluding DV shelters) for the State of Hawaii dropped by 15% from 3,369 to 2,865. The total “vacant beds” when compared to HIC capacity totaled 1,055.
  - Total Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 2,241 including 1,463 on Oahu and 778 on the Neighbor Islands.
  - 25 programs on Oahu and 17 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
  - Several Neighbor Island projects not listed on the 2017 HIC had active clients in the HMIS. These programs are marked in red. These grants are in the process of being consolidated or have lost funding. Future census reporting will reflect this.
- 2) Consent report for intakes during April 2017 (pp. 8-10)
  - The statewide consent to share rate rose slightly from 73% in March to 75% in April among the 1,103 new intakes during the month.
  - Emergency shelter (92%) and Transitional facilities (90%) had the highest Consent rates. Outreach programs had the lowest consent rate (59%).
  - 35 programs had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for exits during April 2017 (pp. 11-13)
  - The average LOS for all programs was 154 days (total of 1,072 exits) representing a significant decrease from 245 in March.
  - Oahu registered the highest LOS with 171 days, followed by Hawaii (161), and Maui (114 days) and Kauai (82 days).
  - Emergency shelter LOS ranged from 40 days on Maui to 117 days on Oahu. Transitional shelter LOS ranged from 115 on Maui to 279 on Oahu. Kauai did not have any transitional shelter exits.
- 4) Timeliness (intake and exits) during April 2017 (pp. 14-18)
  - Intake timeliness fell to 3.26 average days, down from nearly 4 days in previous months.
  - 23 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness held steady at 3.99 average days, similar to the last two months.
  - 26 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter exits.
