Re: June 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the June 2017 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

- 1) End of month, June 2017 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)
 - Increases in emergency shelter occupancy for both Continuums, a large decrease in transitional occupancy on Oahu and no change for BTG transitional facilities resulted in a decreased shelter census on Oahu from 2,475 to 2,374 and an increase on the Neighbor Islands from 751 to 789.
 - Overall, the HMIS end of month homeless census (excluding DV shelters) for the State of Hawaii decreased 2% from 3,226 to 3,163. The total “vacant beds” when compared to HIC capacity totaled 774.
 - Total Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 2,303 including 1,679 on Oahu and 624 on the Neighbor Islands. Oahu street outreach clients increased while the neighbor islands saw a decrease relative to May 2017.
 - 36 programs on Oahu and 21 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- 2) Consent report for entries during June 2017 (pp. 8-11)
 - The statewide consent to share rate increased slightly to 77% from 75% in May, among the 1,241 new adult intakes during the month.
 - Emergency shelters (95%), transitional facilities (92%) and Homeless Prevention (92%) had the highest consent rates. Outreach programs had the lowest consent rate (60%). The consent rate for Permanent Supportive Housing dropped to 65%, considerably lower than 94% in May.
 - 30 programs had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during June 2017 (pp. 12-15)
 - The average LOS for all programs was 158 days (representing 1,111 exits), up 17 days compared to May.
 - Oahu averaged the highest LOS with 175 days, followed by Hawaii (165), Maui (117) and Kauai (80).
 - Emergency shelter LOS ranged from 54 days on Hawaii to 96 days on Oahu. Transitional shelter LOS ranged from 58 on Kauai to 381 on Hawaii.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during June 2017 (pp. 16-21)
 - Intake timeliness rose slightly to 2.92 average days, a small increase compared to May.
 - 33 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter intakes.
 - Exit timeliness dropped to 3.35 average days, a decrease in close to 1 full day relative to May.
 - 23 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter exits.
